



## MTADL A Division – Four Player Format Rules of Play

**Note:** The MTADL General Rules will be used for A division with the exception of specific differences listed below.

- Each team consists of a minimum of four players.
- Games consist of two matches of doubles cricket, two matches of doubles 501 and 16 matches of singles 501.
- Each player plays a maximum of one match of doubles cricket and one match of doubles 501 along with a maximum of four singles 501. **In singles 501, a player can only play a player on the opposing team once.**
- **Recycling is not permitted.** Standard forfeit rules apply so if a team has 3 players, 01 doubles matches will be played with one player, using a “dummy” score of 25 representing the second player until their team score remaining is less than 101. Once the score is lower than 101, the short player will throw alone against the opposing doubles team without help from the dummy score. Cricket matches will be played 2 vs 1 in the case that a team has 3 players.

**Note:** Always be prepared to play matches out of order to ensure continuous play.

- 2 all-stars points will be awarded for:

**501** – 170+ and 101+ High Finish

**Cricket** – 9 Count
